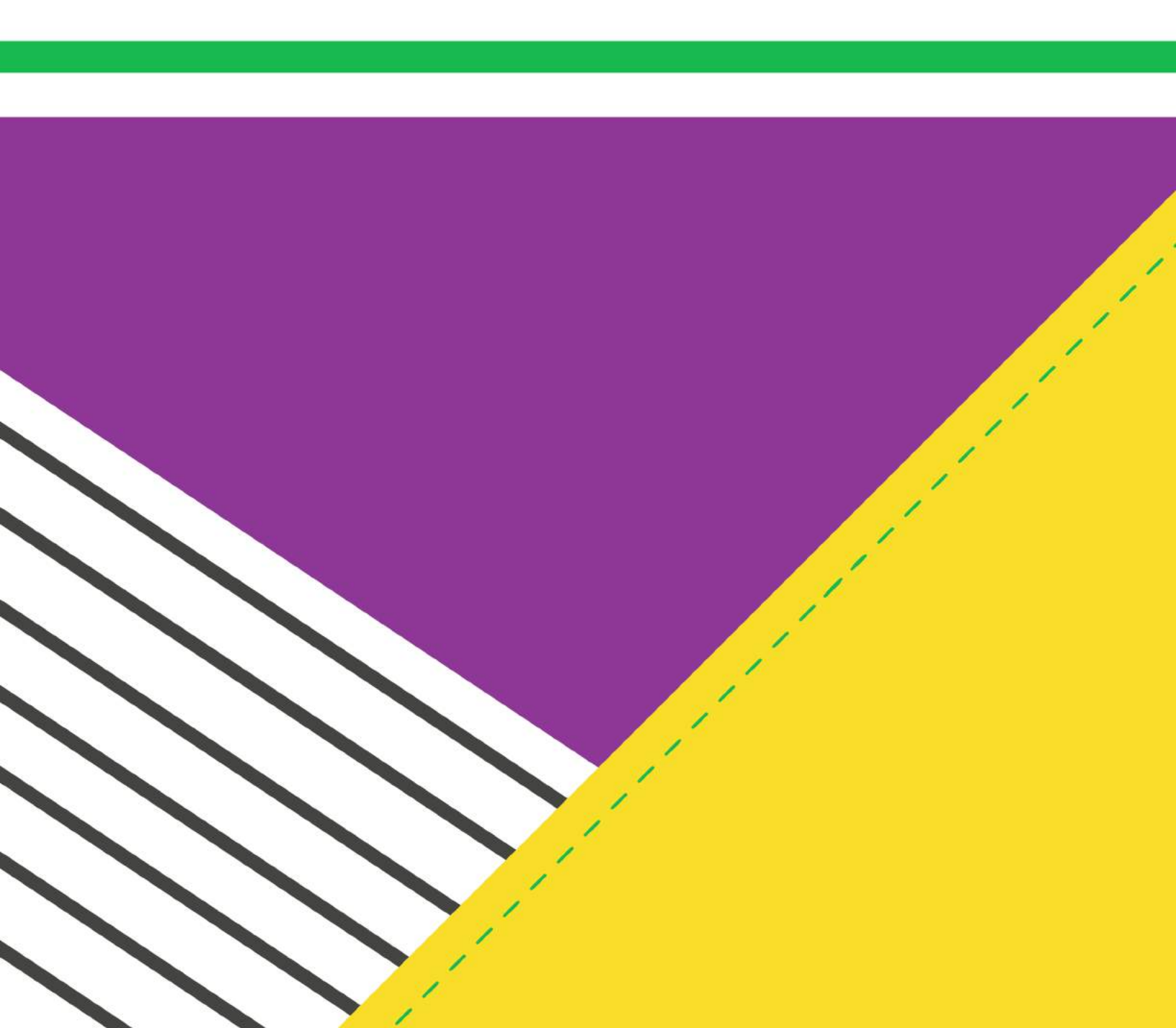

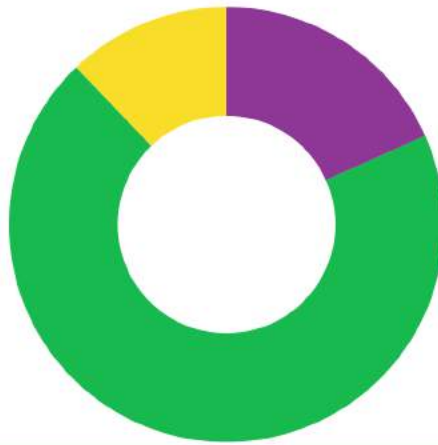
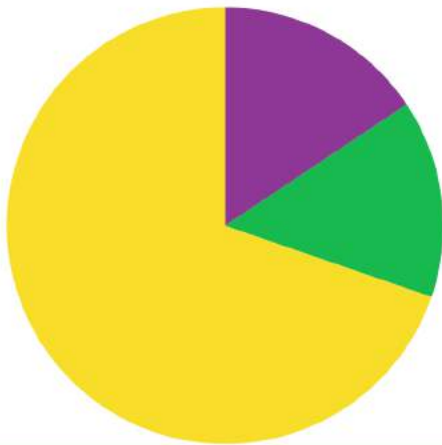

EXPANDING MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVES

In September of 2023 Guilford County Schools (GCS) received a significant boost in mental health support through collaborative efforts involving the Kellin Foundation, North Carolina Community for Justice (NCCJ), and the Guilford County School Board.

Two substantial grants totaling \$6.7 million were secured to reinforce mental health services and expand telehealth accessibility within the GCS community.

In response to the pressing need for enhanced mental health support, GCS received a substantial grant of \$3.7 million from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. This grant significantly bolstered the district's efforts to address mental health concerns. In collaboration with the Kellin Foundation and North Carolina for Community and Justice (NCCJ), GCS launched a pilot program in several high schools aimed at enhancing the district's capacity to identify and address mental health needs with parental consent.

Furthermore, building on the success of school-based telehealth clinics, made possible by a \$3 million grant from the Oak Foundation, GCS expanded its partnership with Cone Health, Guilford County Commissioners, and the Guilford Education Alliance to expand these clinics. This funding enabled the gradual rollout of telehealth services to all 51 Title I elementary schools.

The Kellin Foundation commends Guilford County School's commitment to student well-being and looks forward to continued collaboration in fostering a resilient community. Together, we embrace the spirit of "One Guilford, Better Together."

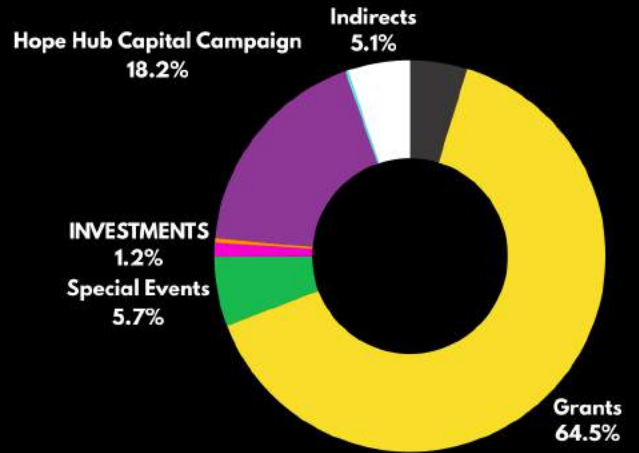
FINANCIAL OUTLOOK: NAVIGATING GROWTH

In 2023, the Kellin Foundation experienced remarkable financial progress, with a notable 53% increase in net income compared to the preceding year. This growth was propelled by generous individual donations, grant funding, and the Hope Hub Capital Campaign. These resources enabled the Foundation to expand its outreach and enhance its programs, furthering its mission of fostering resilience and mental health support within the community. Expenses also rose proportionally, with investments in personnel, services, and infrastructure. The Kellin Foundation's net income for 2023 reaffirms its stability and commitment to community mental health support.

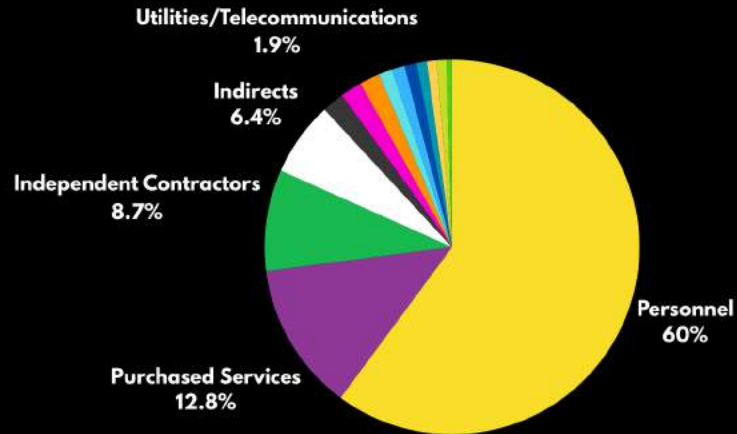

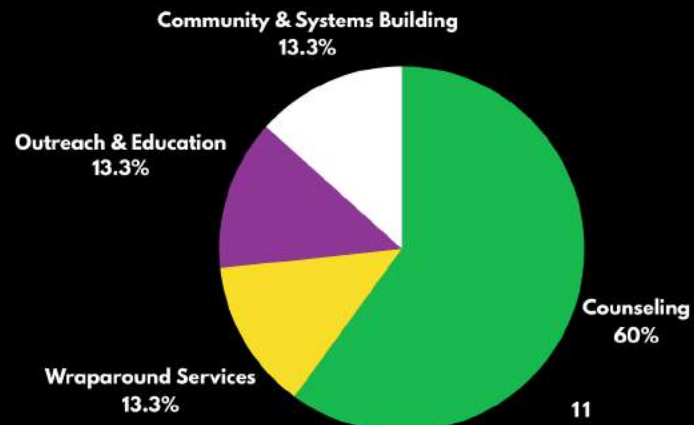
